# Pastor's Letter


Happy Anniversary...?

I've been working here for a year, officially, as of October 11, and as a supply pastor a couple of Sundays before this same date last year. Upon first arrival, I remember being impressed with an education wing filled with actively engaged Sunday school teachers and students. I am still impressed by it. The same goes for the dedicated council reps and other members who continue to do their best to make our congregation as inviting as possible, not just with the facilities, but with a sense of mission and purpose in Christ. 

# TLC Youth Happenings


Rally Day was filled with lots of fun activities for the kids from filling out their All About Me form for Mystery Friends and even a scavenger hunt.

I am writing to you on behalf of our education committee to let you know of a life-changing event available to your middle schoolers and high schoolers. The North American Lutheran Church (NALC), the denomination to which Trinity Lutheran Church has chosen to belong, is offering a time for youth to get to know Jesus Christ in the company of their peers from all over the U.S. and Canada.
