Pastor's Letter

A Time to Heal

We had a successful year as a congregation in 2023, if our success is measured in faithfully spreading the good news of Jesus Christ in word and deed. I leave the details of this success to our 2023 Annual Report, which may be found on our website, or you can get a copy from Tonia or Jenn.

One not-so-pleasant side effect of lots of activity within our faith community has been the transmission of illness. Now many of us have had our own health setbacks with regard to cancer, neurological disorders, and muscle tears. But on top of that we seem to have been passing around the flu, pneumonia, and COVID, none of which are any more fun with the other disorders (think coughing and sneezing.) It is high time we concentrated on healing and for reasons beyond the obvious physical benefits.

Why did Jesus heal those in need of healing? Was it simply so they could feel better? If that's the case, why might he send them on their way with "Go and sin no more"?

There is a goal in Jesus' healing: to return those who are suffering to their community. According to Romans 12 (and 1 Corinthians 12, and Ephesians 4, etc.), we are only complete in Christ as a body with each member contributing their gifts. If a member of our faith community's body is down and out, the whole body suffers when the gifts from the separated member are no longer being contributed to the work of the body. And make no mistake, we are called to

He even admonished his disciples in this way: "So you also, when you have done all that you were ordered to do, say, 'We are worthless slaves; we have done only what we ought to have done!'" (Luke 17:10)

Let's allow the Holy Spirit to act upon us and through us to reengage with each other as God's chosen children. Let's seriously consider how the one who heals us wants us to receive his healing with a graceful response. And let's reimagine our faith community completely centered in Christ. He chose us, he gets us, he heals and forgives us, and he really wants us to live with him forever.
